



Gradings

What is gradings?

In the Martial Art of Taekwondo, gradings are a form of assessment which students undertake to achieve the next belt or stripe. Gradings provide an opportunity for students to perform to their friends, families and peers on what they learnt and trained over the course of the year.

What is the purpose?

The structure and purpose of gradings ensures students are always learning new skills and tuning the old. Every 3-4 months a new challenge awaits students, so they can strive to improve their art, improve their health, gain confidence and be ready to take on anything life may throw at them.

Who is eligible?

Team Taekwondo recommends all newly enrolled students who have trained for at least 2 weeks to grade. All students from little dragons to adult taekwondo practitioners are encouraged to grade.

When is gradings?

Gradings are held at the end of each training term.

Are there costs associated to grade?

Yes. These costs will available closer to the date of the Gradings. Students must pay via the registration link below.

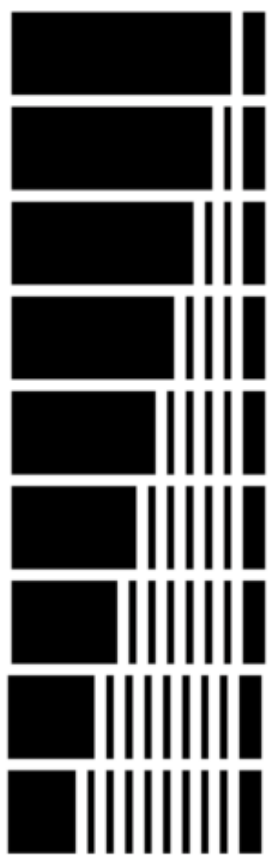
